Spokesmen for the West Gynomineese Litteration Navy today claimed responsibility for the kidnap of Susy from East Camp. Dave Smith has stated that the beloved East Camp Susy will be released only if Bob Brown (head of East Camp Publishing Foundation) comes to West Camp to sing a song at the noon meal.

Brown, in an interview at breakfast this morning, stated that he would "walk through the gates of the West Camp waterfront (which is something like Hell) in order to retrieve our beloved Susy." Police official Mike Creegh stated that Susy was abducted while Brown was in the West Camp office yesterday waiting for the bus. Creegh also stated that Susy was abused very greatly by Smith last night, she was tossed around and thrown behind an old magazine rack at the West Office.

Brown has stated that he will meet all demands to retrieve Susy.
