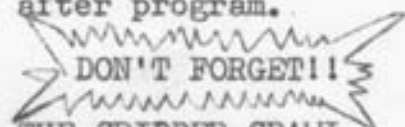
WEST FIELD SPORTS: Rich Billinski had high score on the Range Monday with a 42 - Good shooting Rich!
