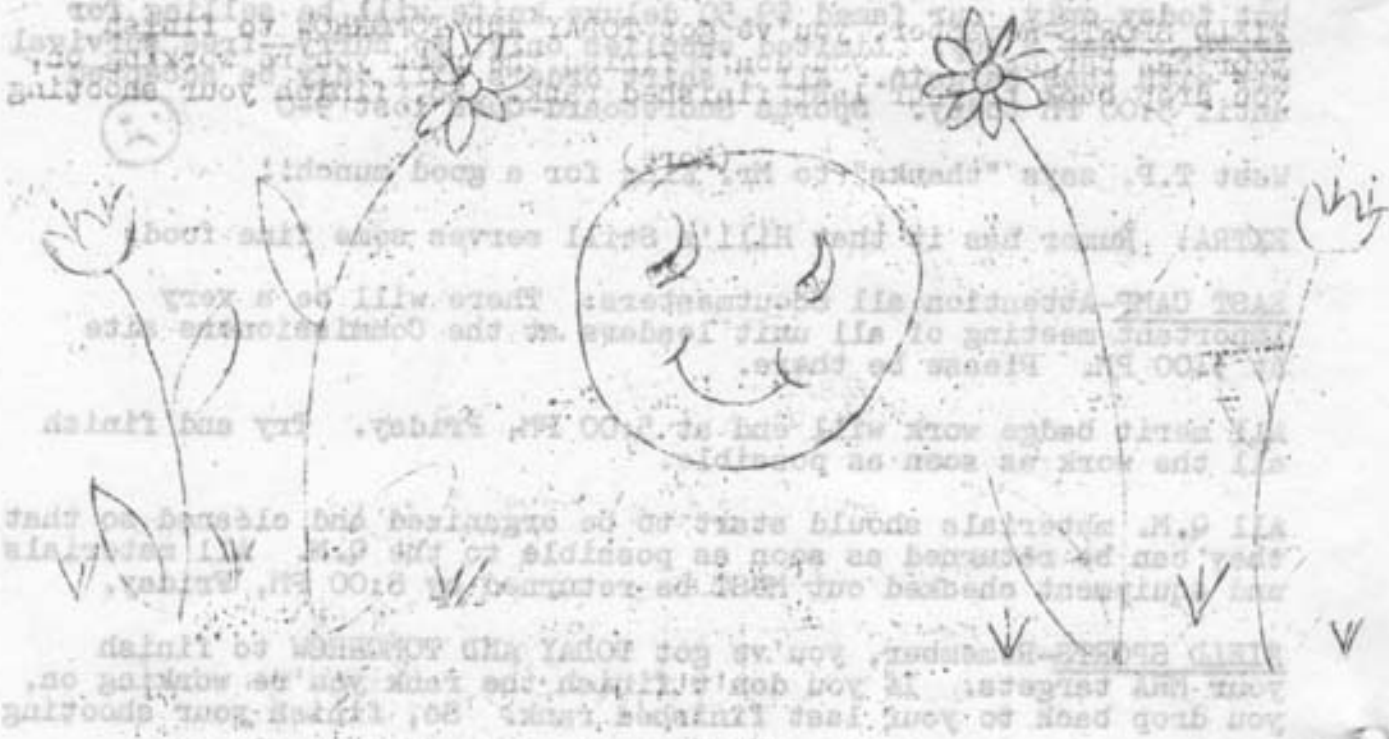
East has horse-back riding this afternoon. See Tom right after lunch.
