FISHING OUTPOST-Harold Simons will be at the Fishing Outpost for Merit Badge sign up all day today.

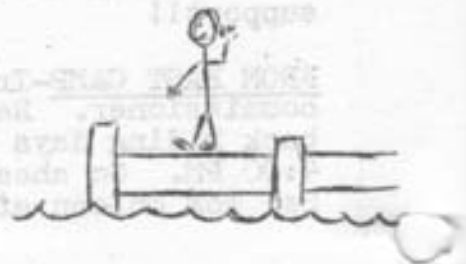
